




About the Author/Illustrator

The Penguin Popsicle Game

In this game, one child pretends to be Julia (Julian for boys) and the rest of the children pretend to be dancing penguins. Julia(n) stands off to the side and faces away from the penguins. The penguins dance until Julia(n) turns around to face them. The penguins have to quickly freeze like Penguin Popsicles. The first person Julia(n) catches dancing becomes the next Julia(n).

If you're a dancer and you know it... Whirl and twirl.


If you're a dancer and you know it... bounce around.

A variation for tamer audiences: *Point your toe... Lift your arms... Wiggle now!*


Penguin Props

The penguins in the story dance with a variety of props - hats and clothes, fans and bows. Add your own props to this penguin below by coloring or gluing on things like pom-poms, feathers, glitter, or beads.



Penguin Family Portrait

Julia tries to make the penguins think she's a penguin too by dressing up as one. If your family members were penguins, what would they look like? Do you have a dad who wears glasses? Does your mom carry a big purse? Do you have a baby brother or sister in diapers? Draw your family as penguins in the picture frame below.



Make a Dancing Penguin

Let's get this party started with your own dancing penguin!

Use black paper and the template on the next page to cut out your dancing penguin's body and flippers. Use white paper for your penguin's tummy and orange paper for your penguin's mouth and feet (or print them on white paper and color them). Don't forget the googly eyes! Then using scraps of patterned paper or craft materials, add your own props to your penguin. Top hat, suspenders, feather boa... Get creative with the props and how you position the flippers and feet to dance!
